MEDICARE COSTS / ENROLLEE 2019-2030 and BEYOND ARE OUT OF CONTROL:

Healthcare Costs are a "Hungry Tapeworm", Eating Away at our Economy!

Medicare Costs of \$796 Billion in 2019 Grow to \$1.7 Trillion by 2030 UP 101%

Medicare Enrollees Projected to Grow from 62 Million in 2020 to 77 million by 2030 UP 25%

Medicare Costs are growing Four (4) Times Faster than Medicare Enrollees 4:1

WE ARE AN AGING COUNTRY - CAN WE MANAGE IT?

Overage 65 population grows to 75 Million by 2030, to 100 Million by 2060 (25% of U.S. Population)

By 2028 all Baby Boomers will be over age 65 and by 2060 only 3 million remain

GOVERNMENT BONUSES and REBATES INFLATE MEDICARE COSTS PER ENROLLEE:

CMS Paid MA Insurers \$450 Billion in Bonuses and Rebates over 24 Years - \$41.8 billion in 2021

MA Rebates pay for copays, coinsurance, hearing, eyecare, dental - enable a 43% MA Market Share

Private Plans Have Never Been Competitive – 2021 MA Payments were 104% of FFS/Enrollee

MedPAC's 2021 Annual Report States: "Aggregate Medicare payments to Medicare Advantage plans have never been lower that FFS Medicare spending".

THE MEDICARE ADVANTAGE QBP IS AN UNPROFESSIONAL SCHEME and A TAXPAYER SCAM:

Rebates up 2020-2021 - from \$35.1 billion to \$41.8 billion vs \$26.9 was projected for 2021

The MA Plan Quality Bonus Plan (QBP) is a subsidy scam – it's Unprofessional / Unethical

Businesses Don't pay Suppliers Bonuses or Rebates for Quality – QBP pays a 50% rebate for 1-star ratings

MedPAC's 2021 Annual Report States: "The current state of quality reporting is such that the Commissions annual updates can no longer provide an accurate description of the quality of care in MA" - also see 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 Annual Reports to Congress

REBATES CREATE UNFAIR COMPETITON and DISCRIMINATORY BENEFIT ELIGIBILITY:

MA Rebates were \$1,680/enrollee (\$41.8 billion) in 2021 – only 27.4 Million MA Enrollees are Eligible 36.3 Million Older Original Medicare Enrollees are Not Eligible – Isn't this Taxation without Representation? Rebates of \$41.8 billion are projected to grow to \$100.8 billion by 2030 – Totaling \$668 billion (2021-2030).
